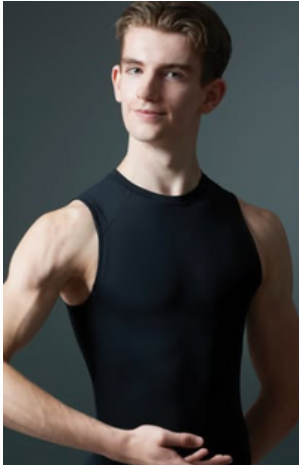
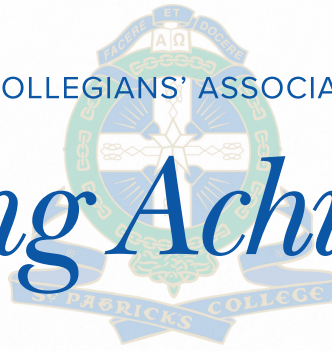

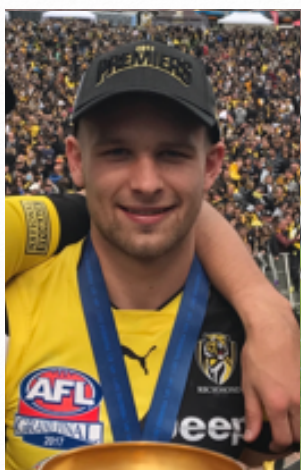


Matthew Short

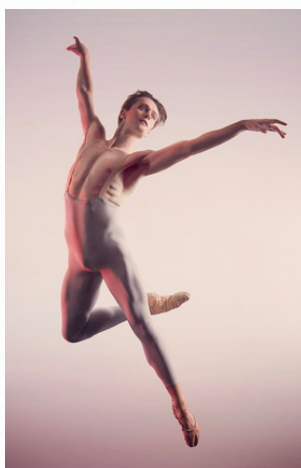


Daniel Rioli

Callum Linane

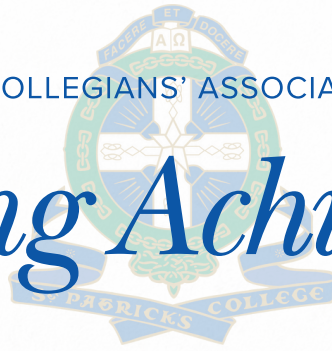
SPC 2008
