TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

- 1. Any variation of the terms and conditions must be made in writing and signed by the Headmaster of St Patrick's College.
- 2. St Patrick's College will provide, and continue providing tuition to the student in the subjects and for the course in which the student has enrolled, subject to the student working regularly and systematically through the course in accordance with instructions, and provided payment of all fees are made in advance. DIMIA through PRISMS (Provider Registration and International Students Management System) will be notified of unsatisfactory attendance and this may result in the cancellation of the student Visa. In the case of illness, a doctor's certificate must be obtained.
- 3. The student undertakes to abide by the rules and regulations of St Patrick's College (as outlined in the School Diary and as amended from time to time) for the running of the school and the conduct of the students.
- 4. Annual Fees (Tuition and Boarding Fees) must be paid in advance with a 50 per cent deposit to be paid on confirmation of enrolment.

All students are required to wear the School's uniform - an additional cost of approximately \$800. All students are required to purchase work books, iPad, equipment and materials - additional cost of approximately \$950.

Tuition fees and charges are revised annually and are correct at the date of publication.

PAYMENT OF COURSE FEES

- a. Fifty per cent of Annual Fees (Tuition and Boarding Fees) are payable on confirmation of enrolment at St Patrick's College. The balance is to be paid at commencement of Term 3.
- b. All fees must be paid in Australian dollars.
- c. If the student changes Visa status (e.g. becomes a temporary or permanent resident) he/she will continue to pay full overseas student's fees for the duration of that calendar year.
- d. No refund will be given if less than three months notice is given to cancel the enrolment application.
- e. Cancellation Fee \$500 charged if less than three months' notice is given.
- f. The Enrolment Fee of \$350.00 is non-refundable.

REFUND OF COURSE MONIES (Standard 3 - National Code)

- a. All notification of withdrawal from a course, or applications for refunds, must be made in writing and submitted to the Headmaster.
- b. If written notice is received within three months of the commencement date of the student's course, the Annual Tuition Fee and Boarding Fee will be refunded.
- c. If written notice is received less than four weeks prior to commencement date of the student's course, 50% of the Tuition Fee will be refunded.
- d. No refund of annual fees will be made where a student's enrolment is cancelled for any of the following reasons:
- i. Failure to maintain satisfactory course progress (visa condition 8202)
- ii. Failure to maintain satisfactory attendance (visa condition 8202)
- iii. Failure to maintain approved welfare and accommodation arrangements (visa condition 8532) [if applicable] iv. Failure to pay course fees
- v. Any behaviour identified as resulting in enrolment cancellation in St Patrick's College's Rules for Students, no refund will be granted.
- e. In the unlikely event that St Patrick's College is unable to deliver selected subjects in full, you will be offered a full refund of all annual fees you have paid. The refund will be paid to you within two weeks of the day on which notification is provided.
- f. This agreement, and the availability of complaints and appeals processes, does not remove the right of the student to take action under Australia's consumer protection laws.

4. Privacy
